Year Three 'IMAX and Melbourne Museum' Excursion

Dear Parents,

This term we are inquiring into 'What changes the Earth?' This learning focuses on the Geography and Science areas of the curriculum.

As part of our inquiry process, the Year 3 students are going on an excursion to the IMAX and Melbourne Museum. On the excursion, the students will learn about the formation of the Earth's surface and how it has changed over time as a result of natural processes and human impacts. They will be exploring and investigating the similarities and differences of animals and vegetation between Africa and Australia due to their similar climates.

We will be travelling to and from the Melbourne Museum by bus. We will have morning tea and lunch in the playground next to the museum. The students will need to bring a small backpack with their morning tea, lunch, warm jumper or jacket and a drink bottle. They should be dressed in full school uniform appropriate to the weather.
